Music: Tuition includes a complete packet of festival music. After acceptance decisions are made, your music will be sent directly to you via US mail. Note: scores will be good-quality Xeroxed copies, and will be copied from Chris Shepard's edit masters, so all of the conductor's marks will already be in place.

Preparation: Participants are expected to be completely musically prepared before arrival at the first rehearsal, as valuable rehearsal time will not be used to teach notes.

Accessibility: The rehearsal/performance space is fully accessible and air-conditioned. Choristers should expect to stand for extended periods during rehearsals and the performance.

Concert Dress - Women: White blouse (not sleeveless), long black skirt or black dress pants, black dress shoes Men: White dress shirt, long tie, black dress slacks, black socks, black shoes

Attendance is mandatory for all rehearsals and the performance. Payment of tuition or acceptance of a student scholarship constitutes a commitment to full participation in the Festival. Tuition is non-refundable.
